# 2024 Year End Report

The 2024 budget was \$263,050. We spent 98% of the budget (\$257,042.53). You generously gave \$237,492.54 which funded 90% of the budget. That amount was 1% lower than 2023. To fully fund the budget we needed \$4,964 per week and on average our giving was \$4,587 per week. Happily, we were able to pay all bills. All UMC Conference billing and Shared Giving Commitments were paid in full.
